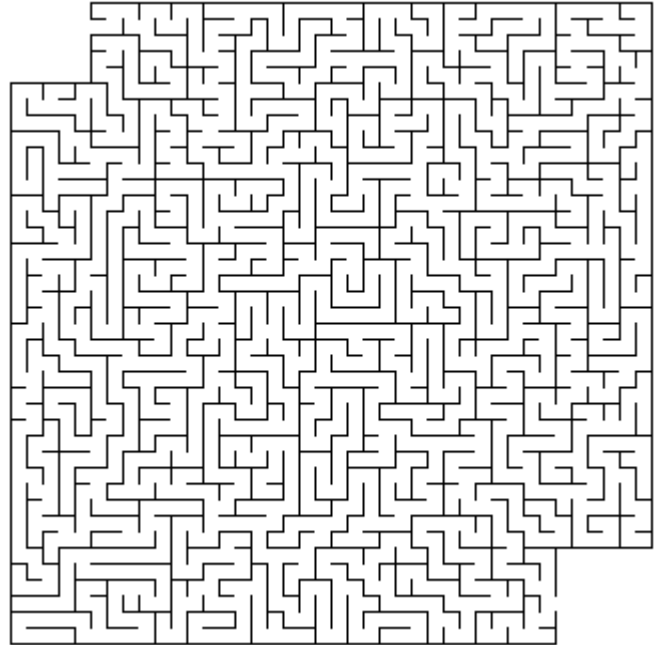

EASY RECIPE

Chocolate Crackle



INGREDIENTS

- ◆ 4 cups rice bubbles
- ◆ 1 cup sifted icing sugar
- ◆ 3 tbsps cocoa (I add more for extra chocolately flavour)
- ◆ 1 cup dessicated coconut
- ◆ 250 g vegetable shortening

DIRECTIONS

1. Combine dry ingredients in large bowl..
2. Melt shortening in saucepan or microwave.
3. Pour melted shortening over dry ingredients and mix until combined.
4. Spoon mixture into 24 paper patty liners.
5. Refrigerate until set.

**Standard 7
Complaints and Disputes**



Saying there is a problem and getting it fixed



You can complain if a service

- does not tell you how you can make a complaint
- does not help you make a complaint
- tells you that you are not allowed to make a complaint
- tells you that you will get into trouble if you make a complaint
- does not try to fix your problem.

**Standard 8
Service Management**



Running the service well



You can complain if a service does not

- follow the Standards or rules
- have a plan to make the service better
- ask you what you think about the service
- does not tell you how they use the money from the government.

- help you learn how to take part in the community
- have respect for the things you do.

Standard 9 Employment Conditions



Having rights at work



You can complain if you don't get your rights at work (employment conditions). For example, if you do not

- get paid what you are entitled to
- get a pay slip
- have safety at work
- get time off when you are sick.
